

STILES TOWN BOARD MONTHLY MEETING – TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 9, 2021

Stiles Town Board held its monthly meeting Tuesday, February 9, 2021 at 6:00 P.M. in the Town Hall Shop due to keeping in compliance with COVID-19 virus restrictions of social distancing.

Chm. Dupuis opened meeting with Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Chm. Dupuis, Supervisors Konitzer and Telford, Treasurer Peterson, and Clerk Magnin.

Agenda approved by motion from Telford, seconded by Konitzer; motion carried.

Clerk' minutes of January 12 Board Meeting and auditing of Town Books read and accepted by motion from Konitzer, seconded by Telford; motion carried.

Treasurer's report given and approved with ending balance \$248,879.76 by motion from Telford, seconded by Konitzer; motion carried.

Jan. bills approved for payment by motion from Konitzer, seconded by Telford; motion carried.

Motion by Konitzer seconded by Telford to approve appointment of Dr. Amy Romandine Kratz to LUP Commission; motion carried. Dr. Romandine Kratz took and signed the oath of office.

Motion by Telford seconded by Konitzer to approve the Oconto Falls Fire Dept. Contract for 2021; motion carried.

Motion by Telford seconded by Konitzer to approve the use of the water truck tender contract for 2 years from Town of Oconto Falls; motion carried.

Discussion followed on billing & collecting for fire calls from Lena and Oconto Falls Fire Depts. and Board checking into expanding building inspection fees for other new construction.

Chm. Dupuis reviewed the survey for Baenen Lane as completed by Shallow Surveying.

Motion by Konitzer seconded by Telford to approve updates made by LUP Commission on map 3.1 to include land east of Fuller Lane and land along Oconto River east of Hwy 141 for RR Rural Residential and R1 Residential; motion carried.

Motion by Konitzer seconded by Telford to approve Davis Agency, Oconto, to appraise land needed by the town to purchase for costs up to \$350.00; motion carried.

Chm. Dupuis reviewed the revised subdivision ordinance supporting the 2 acre and 1 ½ acre concept. Public Hearing will be March 9 at 5:00 P.M. to discuss changes. Pat Virtues, Zoning Office, attending.
