Town of Stiles Annual Town Meeting was held Tuesday, April 20, 2021 at 6:00 P.M. in the Town Hall Shop due to 23 townspeople attending and keeping in compliance with COVID-19 virus restrictions of social distancing.

Present: Chm. Dupuis, Supervisors Telford & Sonesen, Treas. Peterson, & Clerk Magnin.

Chm. Dupuis called meeting to order and led group in Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Supervisors Telford seconded by Sonesen to approve agenda; motion carried.

Chm. Dupuis thanked outgoing Supervisor Blaine Konitzer for his years of service to the town. He also welcomed Dani Sonesen who was elected Supervisor I for the next 2 year term.

Motion by Bruce Jeske seconded by Todd Duame to accept 2020 Annual Town meeting minutes as read by Clerk Magnin; motion carried.

Motion by Bob Kulhanek seconded Don Van Larrhoven to approve treasurer's report as given by Treasurer Peterson; motion carried.

Motion by Larry McGray seconded by Shelley Brennan to accept Clerk's Report and Balance Sheet as given by Clerk Magnin; motion carried. Both Clerk and Treasurers' Reports were printed in the financial booklet available to all townspeople.

Chm. Dupuis reviewed possible plans for road work for this year on Fredrickson, St. Patrick's, Guelig, and Meadow Brook Rds. Motion by Don Van Larrhoven seconded by Chris Hodkiewicz to fix/repair Guelig Rd. from Co. I to approximately Magnin Rd., discussed and voted by show of hands-in favor 8; opposed 6; motion carried.

Discussion by townspeople:

-land locked property end of Larsen Lane, plans for a turn around

-Ambulance Service rising costs for providing a service to the community

-ATVs and opening town roads & signage

-ways to increase revenue to the town

-accumulation/collection of clutter/junk on property

Motion by Bruce Jeske seconded by Don Van Larrhoven to change the town's official newspaper for publication of notices from Times Herald to Oconto Reporter; vote by show of hands-in favor-11, opposed- 1; motion carried.

Motion by Larry McGray seconded by Don Van Larrhoven to give contributions from the town as follows: \$300.00 to Lena Library, \$300.00 to Community Memorial Library, Oconto Falls, \$200.00 to Oconto Area Humane Society and pay 50% of the registration fee per child for kids participating in Lena and Oconto Falls Recreation programs; vote by show of hands-in favor-16; opposed-1; motion carried.
