

## **STILES TOWN BOARD MONTHLY MEETING – WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 13, 2021**

Stiles Town Board held its monthly meeting Wednesday, October 13, 2021 at 6:00 P.M. in the Stiles Town Hall.

Chairman Dupuis opened meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Chairman Dupuis, Supervisors Sonesen and Telford, Treasurer Peterson, Clerk Babino.

Chairman Dupuis called meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

Before agenda was approved, rearrangement was made moving approving operator's license and the treasurer's report as Treasurer Peterson was going to be late. Motion by Sonesen seconded by Telford to approve agenda; motion carried.

Motion by Telford seconded by Sonesen to accept the Clerk's minutes for September 15<sup>th</sup> Board Meeting and September 29<sup>th</sup> Budget Meeting; motion carried.

Motion by Sonesen seconded by Telford to pay bills presented by Clerk Babino and Deputy Clerk Magnin; motion carried.

Motion by Sonesen seconded by Telford to approve operator's license for Crystal Clausen (320 Maple Street, Peshtigo), Eric Lopez (319 South Green Bay Avenue Lot 14, Gillett) and Karen Staerk (5393 Glynn Road, Oconto) for The Store #65; motion carried.

Motion by Sonesen seconded by Telford to table the ambulance contract until the next Board Meeting November 9, 2021; motion carried

Motion by Telford seconded by Sonesen to accept Resolution No. 147-2021 Establishment of Ward Boundaries; motion carried.

Next item of business was discussion from Jerid Staidl regarding the diesel fuel. Staidl Oil will install a device on the Town's tank to be able to see how much fuel is available. If fuel is 30% or below, Staidl Oil will fill tank. Discussion held about contract for the future. Motion by Sonesen seconded by Telford to approve Staidl Oil as the Town's diesel oil distributor; motion carried.

Motion by Telford seconded by Sonesen to donate the old desk to Deputy Clerk Marilyn Magnin that she's used for the last 20 years; motion carried.

Information Only: The next Town Board Meeting will be Tuesday, November 9, 2021 at 5:00 P.M., the Budget Hearing will begin at 6:00 P.M followed immediately following by the Special Town Meeting and ending with the Town Board Meeting.

Information Only: Noise Ordinance Research. Supervisor Sonesen reached out to the DNR but they have no ordinance for waterway noise. The DNR referred Sonesen to the Sheriff's Department. Sonesen left a message for the Sheriff's Department, however, hasn't received a response at this time. Sonesen will continue to follow up.

Information Only: ATV sign placements have been completed by Supervisor Sonesen. The County will be putting a generic ATV route sign by Hwy 141 and St. Patrick's Road and Fuller Lane to HSHS St. Clare Hospital on Main Street and County Road I.

Information Only: Website Enhancements. Supervisor Sonesen compiled a list of updates requested by residents; list given to Supervisor Telford to update online.

Motion by Sonesen seconded by Telford to approve Treasurer's report with ending balance for September 30, 2021, of \$265,374.45; motion carried.

Open question and answer period. Residents asked questions about Fredrickson Road pavement project, the waterway noise ordinance, the Town's website which is [www.townofstiles.org](http://www.townofstiles.org), Crozier's Sand Pit's next step with the County, Railroad on Duame Road, and County using town roads for detour for Hwy 141.

Motion by Sonesen seconded by Telford to adjourn meeting at 7:09 P.M.; motion carried.
