

STILES TOWN BOARD MEETING – WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 10, 2021

Stiles Town Board held its monthly meeting Wednesday, November 10, 2021, at 5:00 P.M. in the Stiles Town Hall. Chairman Dupuis opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Chairman Dupuis, Supervisors Sonesen and Telford, Treasurer Peterson and Clerk Babino. Chairman Dupuis called the meeting to order at 5:02 P.M.
