

STILES TOWN BOARD MEETING – WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 12, 2022

Stiles Town Board held its monthly meeting Wednesday, January 12, 2022, at 6:00 P.M. in the Stiles Town Hall. Chairman Dupuis opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Chairman Dupuis, Supervisors Sonesen and Telford, Treasurer Peterson and Clerk Babino.

Chairman Dupuis called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

1. Approval of Agenda

Motion by Telford seconded by Sonesen to approve the agenda; motion carried.

2. Approval of Minutes

Motion by Sonesen seconded by Telford to approve the December 2021 town board meeting minutes; motion carried.

3. Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Peterson read report. Motion by Sonesen seconded by Telford to approve Treasurer's report; motion carried.

4. List of Bills-amend budget if not enough money (if needed)

Motion by Telford seconded by Sonesen to pay bills presented by Clerk Babino; motion carried.

5. Discuss and vote on Vicki Glasnovich to be secretary of the plan commission

Discussion held with town board and Vicki. Motion by Telford seconded by Sonesen to approve Vicki Glasnovich to be the secretary of the plan commission; motion carried.

6. Discuss the need for an ordinance for the recycle center to enforce the use of blue bags. Ordinance recommended by the Wisconsin Town's Lawyer if we wish to enforce the use of blue bags.

Discussion held. Homeowners pay for 52 bags per year which is included on their annual property tax bill. Additional bags may be purchased at the Town Hall Recycling Center. Supervisor Telford to draft ordinance.

7. Discuss and vote on Christmas/New Years bonus for employees (snowplow drivers, recycle workers, election workers).

Discussion held. Motion by Telford seconded by Sonesen to give snowplow drivers, recycle and election workers each a \$100 New Year's bonus for 2021; motion carried.

8. Informational Only – Noise complaints on the river. Action plan to be provided by Supervisor Sonesen.

Supervisor Sonesen spoke with Paul Hartrick from the DNR. Paul will reach out to the charter fisherman with airboats to discuss concerns. Supervisor Sonesen reached out to Sheriff Todd Skarban and made him aware of this. The town does not need to create an ordinance. If there are any questions, people can contact Paul Hartrick.
