

STILES TOWN BUDGET MEETING –
WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2022

Pledge of Allegiance recited.

Chairman Dupuis called the budget meeting to order at 5:03 PM.

Present: Chairman Dupuis, Supervisors Sonesen and Telford, Treasurer Peterson and Clerk Babino, along with 5 townspeople.

The total 2023 Town Budget of \$601,252.00 was presented by Chairman Dupuis. The town tax levy of \$255,295.00 is an increase of 0.95% which is within the allowable tax levy amount as specified by the State.

After presentation of the 2023 proposed budget, motion by Telford seconded by Sonesen to close the Budget Hearing at 5:17 PM and move into the Special Town Meeting; motion carried.

Chairman Dupuis called the Special Town Meeting to order at 5:17 PM.

Present: Chairman Dupuis, Supervisors Sonesen and Telford, Treasurer Peterson and Clerk Babino, along with 5 townspeople.

1. Establish compensation for elected town officials, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.10(1)(b)1

Discussion held with townspeople. Motion by Bruce Jeske to increase town board wages by 15%; no seconded; Bruce Jeske withdrew his motion. Discussion held. Motion by Vicki Glasnovich seconded by Josh Sonesen to approve 25% raise for board members to include annual wages for chairman \$7,699.95, supervisors \$5,659.95, clerk \$17,236.20 and treasurer \$8,117.40 to begin April 20, 2023; vote by show of hands 10 Ayes and 0 Nays; motion carried.

2. Approve the 2022 town tax levy (to be collected in 2023), pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.10(1)(a)

Motion by Bruce Jeske seconded by Tom Glasnovich to approve the town levy of \$255,295.00; vote by show of hands 10 Ayes and 0 Nays; motion carried.

3. Adjournment

Motion by Sonesen seconded by Telford to adjourn the special elector's meeting at 6:09 PM and move to the Town Board Meeting; motion carried.
