Stiles Town Board held its monthly meeting on Wednesday, February 11, 2026, at 6:00 P.M. in the Stiles Town Hall.

Call to Order and Roll Call - Chairman Flynn called the meeting to order at 6:05 P.M. and roll call done.

2. Lot sizes 2 acres **Recommendation to change North of 22 to 2 acres, next step is public hearing**
3. Compactor contract **Waste Management & GFL: With our tonnage WM is historically the better deal, WM will do a service check on our compactor. Motion by Peterson to continue with Waste Management, seconded by Telford, motion carried.**

1. Kevin Schneider Land Division **Wants to divide his approximately 5 acres, county had no issues, no issues with flood plain or wetlands, will remain at least 2 acres each, Motion by Telford, seconded by Peterson, motion carried**

2. TextmyGov notifications for town **Would text notifications to Town Residents, \$3750, too expensive for the size of our town, not interested at this time**
3. Fire department Meeting/fire protection ordinance/fee schedule **Flynn met with Tim Magnin regarding our contract, they do not bill us for calls, How is it fair if Oconto Falls does not bill but Lena does. Per State statute the town is responsible for traffic control; however the town can bill DOT or CTY if resident does not respond to our attempts to collect. Get more data on actual calls and review contracts (ends 2027)**
4. Subdivision ordinance **Different aspects discussed and things to consider**
5. Ambulance board meeting update **Annual meeting July 29th, more updates after April meeting**
