Stiles Town Board held its monthly meeting on Wednesday, March 11, 2026, at 6:00 P.M. in the Stiles Town Hall.

Call to Order and Roll Call - Chairman Flynn called the meeting to order at 6:03 P.M. and roll call done.

1. Co I annexation **Update from Peter Willis was printed and for anyone to read.**
2. Lot sizes 2 acres north of HWY 22 **Motion by Peterson to amend the lot size ordinance from 5 acres to 2 acres, seconded by Telford, motion carried.**
3. Joint Libraries **Update by Peterson: We would have to take from town account to pay towards library, could be \$40,000 first year, does not sound beneficial to the town due to cost.**

New Business

1. New compactor replacement pricing **Flynn went over quote from Waste Management, if we do need to replace the compactor it will affect recycling charge**
2. Duame Road railroad crossing **Per Flynn, it is on the calendar for the week of July 27th to be repaired, the railroad already has the materials to do the repairs. Railroad pays excavating, town pays for paving, a culvert will be put in before the tracks**

3. Chicken Shack Bridge Aid Petition **Motion by Telford to approve resolution R2026-01 for Bridge Aid, seconded by Peterson, motion carried**
4. Humane Society Agreement **Do we need to keep contract w/ the Humane Society, agreed that it is good to have them as a back-up. Motion by Peterson to approve renewing contract, seconded by Telford, motion carried**
